TH 19/993 TO ELECT A CHAIRMAN FOR THE MEETING.

Proposed by Cllr D Shopland, seconded by Cllr Goodliffe and **AGREED** that Cllr Hill should be Chairman of the meeting.

7.31 PM INFORMAL BUSINESS –

TO RECEIVE AND NOTE REQUEST FOR DOUBLE YELLOW LINES AT MARINE PLACE AND PYNE POINT

A resident from Pyne Point advised Committee members of his views and he was also representing neighbouring residents concerns regarding the parking of vehicles at the entrance to Pyne Point. The resident expressed the dangers and difficulties being experienced by pedestrians, people with buggies, disabled etc., that try to cross this road. Currently numerous work vans and other vehicles are parking on the entrance to Pyne Point daily, restricting the visibility to those vehicles entering and exiting Pyne Point. On occasion, rubbish collections haven't taken place due to the lorries not being able to gain access into the road. Emergency vehicles have also experienced difficulties using the road, which cumulated in a road closure being installed by the Police to safeguard the emergency at the time. A request for double yellow lines, in line with Highway regulation, would be welcomed by the residents of Pyne Point to make this area much safer for all.
