YPC 8/17 RECEIVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr J. Geldart (family commitments, A Giles-Townsend (work commitment) D. Shopland via Cllr Francis-Pester (another commitment)

YPC 9/17 RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST FOR ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

There were no declarations of interest on items on the agenda.

YPC 10/17 RECEIVE INFORMATION ON PROVISION FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The information from Cllr Middleton and Cllr Little had been included in the spreadsheet. It was **AGREED** that Cllr Middleton & Cllr Fone would use the spreadsheet as a base, populating the information requirements for the individual organisations. Members noted that there are a lot more organisations than those on the list and their information also needs to be added; it was expected that other Committee Members would provide additional information on groups and organisations in the parish offering services or facilities for the age range 11-21. Members were requested to provide their information to the Town Clerk.

Members **AGREED** that once the database has been completed it will be uploaded on to the Town Councils web site under its own heading to provide a searchable resource for those providing or looking for services and/or facilities.

Members discussed the next step once the database was completed. Members **AGREED** to investigate the formation of a youth council, to provide a platform for the youth of the community.

ACTION: Cllr Fone & Town Clerk to provide a summary of the youth council case studies.

Members discussed the creation of a 25 year vision for Clevedon incorporating the work done by the Neighbourhood Plan and the Clevedon Coastal Community Team.

YPC 11/17 RECEIVE INFORMATION ON NSC PLAYING FIELD POLICY CONSULTATIONS

Members were informed that NSC is carrying out a consultation and survey for a Playing Pitch Strategy. Looking at all sports provision in the district covering all facilities whether public or privately owned and run, including indoor and outdoor facilities. The report is scheduled to be available in a year's time but NSC have agreed to provide the data relating to Clevedon as soon as they receive it.
