TEA/18/767 ITEMS ARISING FROM INFORMAL BUSINESS ABOVE;

767.1 NSC Streets & Open Spaces Update

Mr Gareth Withers provided the following updates:

- *Seafront Railings Re-Painting*
 Pelican Business Services have painted 120 metres of the railings, with a further 145 metres left to do. Mr Withers has arranged for a local contractor to finish the work.
- *Strode Road Playing Fields*
 All defective bollards have been replaced around the perimeter and overspill car park at Strode Road.
- *Jet Ski's*
 A new graphic is on order for the RNLI Beach entrance signs to comply with the new Environment Agency Water Quality warning notices. Proofs of which were available to Councillors at the meeting.
- *Seafront Paving by Clevedon Sailing Club*
 The loose paving slabs have been replaced.
- *Noticeboard on the promenade*
 New design boards have been quoted for and the Weston Seafront team will be funding the renovation of the boards. The board design was available to Councillors in the meeting.
- *Salthouse Fields footpath improvements*
 Current phase of path work is complete. Investigations are now taking place for a ramp for the path at the rear of the tennis courts.

770.1 Seafront paving by Clevedon Sailing Club

- There is still one loose slab that needs attention.
- An artist frequents a hardstanding area by the sailing club most weekends and does not hold a street licence. Unloading of his work is done by moving a vehicle onto the paving, which will cause it to break up again.

Noticeboard on the promenade

- NSC to be approached to ascertain if the Council can manage the provision for notices on the new boarding.

Steps at the back of the bowling club

- The steps are now considered to be dangerous and need attention.

Badger bridge, Poets Walk

- NSC to be asked to seek further repairs to the bridge as it is breaking up. The felting on the sloped sections of the bridge are coming away too.
