RESOLVED: To inform NSC that the Town Council can only maintain Town Council owned bus shelters.</p> <p>KENN ROAD OUTSIDE LLOYDS TOYS – TOWN CENTRE BUS SHELTER – NSC had investigated relocating the bus stop outside the Conservative Club however the number of services in the footway, the zig zag markings of the pedestrian crossing and the proximity of the corner made this infeasible. The new proposed location outside Lloyds Toys is on a wider part of the road where the footway can be built out (by 1 metre) to enable better passage for pedestrians and the possibility of a shelter to be installed in the future should this be required. The bus stop opposite would be re-located slightly in the event of two buses arriving at stops at the same time. RESOLVED: Not to support a bus stop at this location as visibility would be reduced and traffic obstructed. Suggest the bus stop remains where it is at present.</p>	Office to action Office to action
