801.1 NSC STREETS & OPEN SPACES UPDATE

Seafront paving by Clevedon Sailing Club – Members were advised that the contractor is due back this month to correct the loose paving stone.

The gentleman selling paintings on the hardstanding by the Sailing club is not permitted to trade in this area as he doesn't hold a street licence.

Surface of promenade near Little Harp Pub and Amusement arcade – Members were advised the contractor is coming back this month to finish the work. Also, to install a ramp on the path behind the Bowling club.

Noticeboard on the promenade – Members were advised to contact Dick Berry, NSC regarding events in the town to be published on the boards. A central collection point for posters to be arranged somewhere in the town.

Badger bridge improvements on Poets Walk – Members were advised that some 'patching' work has been affected to the bridge. Repairs only remedial as further works are being planned from funds given from the England Coast Path group and Natural England.

Painting of seafront railings – The painting of the railings is nearing completion.

Members were advised that the raised kerb within the pathway will be lowered to create a natural slope allowing easier access for wheelchair users.

Clevedon Sailing Club Committee – Cllr Hatch reported the club is doing well. Well supported by the Gig and swimming clubs and Marlens. The Club is also continuing to lobby NSC regarding ownership of the slipway.

Clevedon Twinning Association – No report

CANS – Cllr Hatch advised the lease on the building is due to expire in July 2019. CANS only use the building 2-3 days a week and reported damp issues in the building too. Due to the Job Centre moving to Castlewood offices, there is a significant drop in footfall. CANS have been offered space at the Castlewood offices which they are investigating. Members of the Committee asked that this be raised at the next Property Committee meeting.
