

# Clevedon Town Council

Minutes of the meeting of the Transport and Highways Committee Meeting held at 10.30pm on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2024 at Clevedon Town Council offices.

1304. To receive apologies for absence.

There were no apologies for absence.

1305. To receive declarations of interest for items on the agenda.

There were no declarations of interest.

1306. To elect a Vice Chairman of Transport and Highways Committee for 2024/2025.

It was resolved to elect Councillor Kevin O'Brien as Vice Chairman.

1307. To receive and ratify the minutes of the Transport and Highways meeting dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

It was resolved to approve the minutes as being a correct record of the meeting.  
The Chairman signed the minutes as being a true record of the meeting.

1308. To discuss NSC proposal for road improvements / traffic calming on Highdale Road and costings for the proposal.

The Town Clerk will ask North Somerset Council for more information about their plans in relation to Highdale Road. The Town Clerk was also asked to enquire about an update on the repairs to the NSC owned wall in Highdale Road.

1309. To consider Town Council support for the implementation of pedestrian crossings at the junction of Great Western Rd and Kenn Rd.

The matter was debated and it was felt that this could be one of a number of locations to be considered in the town.

It was noted that the cost of a new pedestrian crossing in the Town, if requested by the Town Council, would be in the region of £50,000.

It was resolved to make a request to the Finance and General Purposes Committee that an amount of £100,000 should be included in the 2025-26 budget for road improvement schemes.

Committee members were asked to bring suggestions to an informal meeting of committee members on 28<sup>th</sup> November.

1310. To consider the Town Council's response to a disabled parking bay application in Westbourne Crescent.

It was resolved to support the application with a condition that the disabled space should be at right-angles to the pavement, not parallel to the pavement as is being suggested.

The Town Clerk will enquire whether North Somerset Council regularly check to see if the resident who has the disabled bay is still living at this location, and that they still meet the criteria for a disabled bay.

1311. To consider a request for Town Council support for the installation of double yellow lines at Albert Road.

It was resolved to support a request for double yellow lines. Councillors O'Brien and Shopland will liaise with the Town Clerk in submitting an application to North Somerset Council.

1312. Nailsea and District Community Transport – information update.

The Chairman provided an update on the service provided by this organisation.

Update on Transport Hub (NSC Queen Square Market Stand for Public / Theatre Workshop Presentation for Business – 7<sup>th</sup> Nov).

The Town Clerk was asked to contact the North Somerset Council officers who are working on the Transport Hub project to ask for an update on their work, and full details of all the ideas being considered.
